What's Growing?

Farmer Stalling grows a variety of vegetables and fruits. April-November The following are available in season: cucumbers, yellow squash, tomatoes, sweet potatoes, collard greens, turnip and mustard greens, green beans, new potatoes, turnips, rutabagas, butterbeans, zucchini, beets, sweet corn, peppers, eggplant, field peas, cantaloupe, and watermelon.

Buying from T&K Farm

Deliveries to child care facilities will take place on Monday or Tuesday in Northern and Eastern Wake County; the minimum order is \$75. Farmer Stallings also sells his produce on Tuesday, Friday and Saturday mornings at the Franklin County Farmers' Market in Louisburg.
