SECTION I - OVERVIEW

BackgroundNorth Carolina Session Law 2017-57 Section 11B.9 provides funding to the Smart
Start network to implement Dolly Parton's Imagination Library (DPIL) for FY
2017-18 and FY 2018-19. Currently 49% of counties implement Dolly Parton's
Imagination Library, serving 8% of eligible children across the state. The goal is
to take the initiative statewide. The statewide goal is to have over 41.5%
(250,000/602,152) enrolled by FY 2019.

Scope of Work Wake County SmartStart (WCSS) is seeking a Project Lead to coordinate and manage the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library Expansion Initiative.

Recruit Families

- o Create and implement a Dolly Parton recruitment plan
- Recruit <u>20,000</u> new DPIL enrollees for fiscal year 2017-18
- Recruit additional <u>20,000</u> DPIL enrollees for fiscal year 2018-19

<u>Outreach Communication</u>

• Promote registration through a variety of outlets, including social media

Data Entry

• Enter information from paper applications into the centralized Dolly Parton's Imagination Library Expansion Funds database

Handle Undelivered Books

- Pick up undelivered books from the post office and deliver them to other locations for public use
- Enrollment Reporting and Verification
 - Provide regular enrollment updates to ensure that targets are finetuned
- Participate in the Evaluation
 - Encourage families to participate in the survey
- Early Literacy Coordination
 - Promote early literacy initiatives with community partners and organizations



<u>System of Support</u>	WCSS will provide a system of support in all aspects to meet the Scope of Work and deliverables.
Funding	Funding per Child Enrolled: The Project Lead will receive a supplement of \$1.80 per enrolled. These funds will be used to support implementation of the program.
